Round Rock July 4th



Fun for Families

Join the fun this Monday, July 4th by bringing your family to this year's Fireworks and Frontier Days Celebration! The 42nd annual festival will begin with a parade at 10am through Downtown Round Rock that will last until noon. Special guests will include KTBC FOX 7 with Hank Hill, Mayor Nyle Maxwell, and more. The parade will start at First Texas Bank (corner of Lee Street and Round Rock Avenue) and will proceed through Historic Downtown ending at the Sam Bass Little League Baseball fields. Parade prizes will be awarded for Best Marching Unit, Best Riding Unit, Best Overall, Best Civic, Best Commercial, Most Spirited, Most Beautiful and Best Related to theme. The theme this year is Western Traditions. If you are interested in submitting a float into the parade, go to the city website, www.ci.round-rock.tx.us/parks-rec/july_fourth, where you can mail or fax your application. For vendor booth information, call Dominic Digesualdo at 423-1026. After the parade, Old Settler's Park transforms into the Wild West as Round Rock's history is reenacted with the famous Sam Bass shootout. Guests can also enjoy arts and crafts, food booths, moon bounces, picnicking, volleyball, horseshoes, a Pepper Eating contest and Ballet Folklorico. Free watermelon will be served at 7pm at the Lakeview Pavilion. Skydivers will kick off the evening Independence festivities, and the fireworks display will begin around 9:30pm accompanied by music from the Austin Symphonic Band.

*Keep in mind, the city of Round Rock explicitly prohibits the sale or use of any fireworks. Use or possession of fireworks is a Class 1 Misdemeanor with a fine of up to \$1000 and/or six months in jail. Let's keep our neighborhood safe!
